HOW TO PAY:

1. By cheque (Made payable to Knowle Golf Club).
2. By Credit or Debit Card (In person or by telephoning the office on 0117 9770660).
3. Via Direct Debit with Future Financials Ltd (10 monthly instalments - Terms and Conditions and Application forms available from the office). **Those who already pay via this method, need not take any action other than to ensure their Direct Debit with Future Financials Ltd remains active.**

WHEN TO PAY:

Please note the following, taken from Club Rule 13:

*"If any member shall fail to pay their annual subscription or complete a direct mandate **on or before 1st April**, notice shall be sent to them calling their attention thereto and **if they do not pay by 15th April, they shall cease to be a member of the Club.** A member who fails to pay the annual subscription by 1st April shall not be eligible to enter Club Competitions. This ineligibility shall stand until payment is made."*

PROCEDURE FOR COLLECTION OF MEMBERSHIP BAG-TAG:

Following feedback at last year's AGM, we will not be enclosing the membership sticker with the renewal invoice. Instead, these will be left for collection behind the bar once payment has been made. If you require a new tag to display this sticker, please contact the office.

In 2012, all members are expected to attach their 2012/13 stickers to their golf bags and no one should be offended when staff or committee members request this confirmation on the 1st or 10th tee. This applies to everyone equally and there will be checks made throughout the season.

CHANGES TO THE RULES REGARDING COMPETITION WINNINGS:

As an additional option, this year, members may request that prize winnings be added to their Bar Card or; used to reduce the amount payable on the following year's annual subscription.

To exercise this additional option, members are required to notify the office no later than 1st April 2012 and then any monies won during the course of the season will be paid out in accordance with their choice.

Any member who has not given notification before 1st April will receive Professional Shop Vouchers for the remainder of the season.
