



Important Information About WHS Slope Charts

These slope charts remain valid for identifying Course Handicap for General Play score submission and identifying Course Handicap for all Social Golf including inter Club Seniors and Stragglers Matches.

For all official Knowle competitions Players should refer to their IG App, IG Members Website, or the PSI Screens, to obtain their Playing Handicap, or Shot Allowance, as it can no longer be calculated from the Rounded Course Handicap shown on these Slope Charts.

Please also note the application of shot allowances in match play events has been changed so that the % is applied to the difference between the players course handicaps, taken from the lowest player upwards.

The noticeboard outside the main entrance also shows the relevant % handicap allowance that should be used depending on the format played.

Example of how to Calculate Stroke Allowances in Social 4BBB Match Play (Including Inter Club Seniors and Stragglers Matches)

- Look up the rounded course handicap for each player using their handicap index on the slope charts located on the noticeboard by the main entrance.
- Calculate 90% of difference between each Players course handicap and the Player with the lowest course handicap.
- The Player with the lowest course handicap plays off zero strokes with the other players receiving the rounded 90% of the difference.

As an example:
